Code of Regulations

Section 1. The Board of Trustees shall be the governing board of the corporation and shall consist of seven trustees. The membership of the board of the City of Canton to be designated by the Mayor, an appointed or elected official of the City of Canton to be designated by the Mayor and two member of the Council of the City of Canton to be designated by the Mayor, ex-officio. Any ex-officio member who ceases to hold the office held at the time of appointment as a member shall thereupon cease to be a member of the Board of Trustees. The other three Trustees shall consist of a representative of the Greater Canton Chamber of Commerce, a person representing the interest of local labor, and a local business woman. Those three Trustees shall serve for one year terms, except as otherwise provided.

§ 1724.01. Community improvement corporations.

A corporation not for profit may be organized in the manner provided in section 1702.04 of the Revised Code, and as provided in sections 1724.01 to 1724.09, inclusive, of the Revised Code, for the sole purpose of advancing, encouraging, and promoting the industrial, economic, commercial, and civic development of a community or area
